About the Playhouse: Pasadena Playhouse is one of the top regional theaters in the country, the State Theater of California, and the 2023 Regional Theatre Tony Award recipient. Under the leadership of Producing Artistic Director Danny Feldman, it presents a full season of artistically innovative productions and engaging educational outreach activities to nearly 150,000 Southern California residents annually in two spaces: the 643-seat main stage theater and the 99-seat flexible Carrie Hamilton Theater. By focusing on the creation of great productions, the expansion of educational and outreach programs, the development of new plays, and the creation of innovative programs to build community, The Playhouse will boldly lead the field into the next 100 years of great theater.

About the position: The Camp Counselor will be an integral part of Pasadena Playhouse's first-ever children's summer camp, Playhouse Players: *Madagascar Jr.!* Under the direction of our Education Program Coordinator and Camp Director, the Camp Counselor will assist our Camp instructors as they rehearse and produce a 30 minute version of *Madagascar Jr.* with campers aged 7-12. The Camp Counselor will provide classroom management and support to our Directors and Choreographer in the rehearsal room, supervise campers' check-in/check-out, lunch, and snacktimes, plus help facilitate fun activities and games with the campers. Campers will act as mentors and constant chaperones to our young campers as they rotate through their daily schedule.

Pasadena Playhouse seeks a high-energy, responsible young person at least 15 years of age with experience and a passion for both musical theatre and also working with children. Dance, acting, and piano skills are a plus, but not required. The ideal candidate should have a strong initiative, excellent communication skills, and is a confident and quick problem-solver. Our Camp Counselors will need to have the energy and patience to corral elementary-schoolers, creating a fun and safe environment for our campers as they not only put on a fully-realized musical, but also build an ensemble and develop their social-emotional learning.
